Introduction

Mobile Mini recognises that acts of Modern Slavery remain a real risk, both to our Business and within the Supply Chains in which we operate; we understand that it is our responsibility to be alert to those risks. We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships; taking reasonable steps to ensure slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in any Business or Organisation that has any relationship with our Company.

Our Supply Chain

We will not maintain a relationship with any Business or Organisation that is known to be involved in slavery or human trafficking and expect all those in our supply chain and their associated contractors to comply with our values.

As part of the due diligence processes to identify and mitigate potential areas of risk within our direct supply chain, Mobile Mini takes the following actions;

- Where appropriate we maintain long standing relationships with key suppliers and ensure that our expectations in relation to business behaviour are clear
- To reflect the need for greater control over our supply chain, we operate a detailed application procedure as part of the selection process for potential key suppliers.
- We have systems in place to encourage reporting of concerns and protect whistle blowers.

Training

We will ensure that all staff are aware of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking and communicate additional information that supports this as appropriate. All Directors have been briefed on the subject.
